MESSAGE OVERVIEW

Part 1: The Story of Us | Delivered by Kim Davies-Graham

Scripture: Ephesians 1:3 – 14: Identity in God

Ask the question: What story do you want to tell?

Part 2: Get in The Game | Delivered by Tiana Miles

Bottom Line: We were created to be unique. We all play a part in the future of the world. The way that we choose to fulfil our role as a child of God, **determines the potential of our planet.**

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12 – 31

Ask the question: What kind of world do I want to live in? How can I use my skills and begin to make the world a better place?

Part 3: A Neighbourhood Kind-Of Love | Delivered by Murray Grant

Bottom Line: Love wasn't created to be lonely, but plentiful and generous. The way that we love ourselves was created so that we could share it with others.

Scripture: Mark 12: 30 - 31

Ask the question: What kind of world do I want to live in? How can I use my skills and begin to make the world a better place?

Part 4: Building a Better Future | Delivered by Mac Smith
