A relational pedagogy is at the heart of working restoratively in schools and it provides young people with high challenge while demonstrating high levels of support across all dimensions of the students’ development. With such an approach we can build and nurture deliberate developmental relationships in order to inspire our students to greater growth academically, personally, and socially.

This short introductory webinar sets the scene for teachers in schools to teach more authentically with mind and heart. A much longer experiential workshop planned for 2021 will enable teachers to more fully explore this concept of teaching through developmental relationships.
